It is funny as Paul is writing this letter .. again he is a prisoner, however, this time in Rome. Paul was writing this letter in response to a gift that was sent by the church through Epaphroditus.

### Background:

The theme of the epistle of Philippians is one of JOY Joy in the Lord

This letter teaches us in a practical way how to have and experience joy. Please remember when Paul was writing this letter he was in a dungeon in Rome .. not a very pleasant place to be, however, again and again we will be instructed how to have joy and experience joy while facing hard times.

As we go through this epistle we will be facing and dealing with the following questions: What is life? What is death? Meaning of justification by faith, doctrine of resurrection, what does it mean to be glorified, the meaning of real prayer.
