What is the definition of addiction ..

*Addiction is the **repeated** involvement with a substance or activity, despite the substantial **harm** it now causes, because that involvement was (and may continue to be) pleasurable and/or valuable.*

Proverbs 25:28 NLT

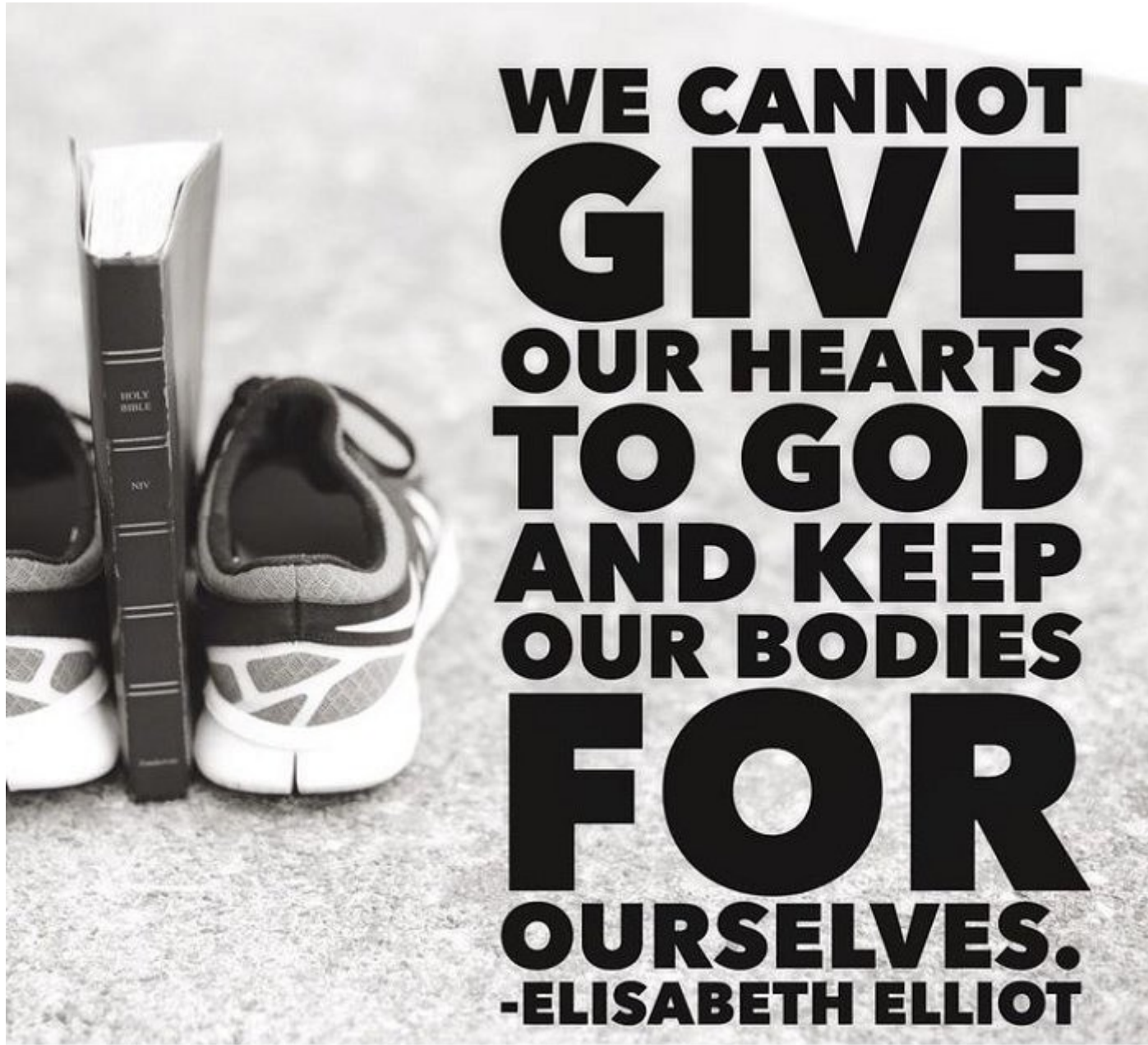
